A BILL

To require the design of the obverse side of the \$1 coin
to depict the Statue of Liberty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Statue
5 of Liberty \$1 Coin Act of 1998”.

6 **SEC. 2. STATUE OF LIBERTY \$1 COIN.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5112(d)(1) of title 31,
8 United States Code (as amended by section 4(d) of Public
9 Law 105–124) is amended by inserting after the 4th sen-
10 tence the following new sentence: “The obverse side of the

1 dollar coin shall have a design depicting the Statue of Lib-
2 erty.”.

3 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

4 (1) The 6th sentence of section 5112(d)(1) of
5 title 31, United States Code (as amended by sub-
6 section (a) of this section) is amended by striking
7 “appropriate designs for the obverse and the reverse
8 sides” and inserting “an appropriate design for the
9 reverse side”.

10 (2) Section 4(e)(1) of Public Law 105–124 is
11 amended by striking “, as amended by this section”.
