Mr. Hayworth introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

## A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of the Woodland Lake Park tract in Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest in the State of Arizona to the town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, WOODLAND LAKE PARK
- 4 TRACT, APACHE-SITGREAVES NATIONAL FOR-
- 5 EST, ARIZONA.
- 6 (a) Conveyance Required.—The Secretary of Ag-
- 7 riculture shall convey, without consideration, to the town
- 8 of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona (in this section referred to
- 9 as the "town"), all right, title, and interest of the United

- 1 States in and to a parcel of real property, including im-
- 2 provements thereon, consisting of approximately 583 acres
- 3 in Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest in the State of Ari-
- 4 zona and known as the Woodland Lake Park tract, for
- 5 the purpose of permitting the town to use the parcel as
- 6 a public park and for other recreational purposes.
- 7 (b) Description of Property.—The exact acreage
- 8 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
- 9 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
- 10 factory to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be
- 11 borne by the town.
- 12 (c) REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—During the five-year
- 13 period beginning on the date the Secretary makes the con-
- 14 veyance under subsection (a), if the Secretary determines
- 15 that the conveyed real property is not being used in ac-
- 16 cordance with the purpose of the conveyance specified in
- 17 such subsection, all right, title, and interest in and to the
- 18 property, including any improvements thereon, shall revert
- 19 to the United States, and the United States shall have
- 20 the right of immediate entry onto the property. Any deter-
- 21 mination of the Secretary under this subsection shall be
- 22 made on the record after an opportunity for a hearing.
- 23 (d) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The
- 24 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
- 25 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection

- 1 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
- 2 interests of the United States.

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
