## A BILL

To establish temporary enrollment priorities for the conservation reserve program.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. PRIORITY ENROLLMENT OF CERTAIN LANDS IN 4 CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM. 5 (a) Temporary Enrollment Priorities.—During the period specified in subsection (b), the Secretary of Ag-7 riculture shall give the highest priority to the enrollment 8 of croplands in the conservation reserve program that— 9 (1) are located in a county that has been de-10 clared either a presidential or secretarial disaster

1	area during three out of the preceding five years;

3	(2) are located in an area repeatedly infected
4	with Fusarium graminearum or vomitoxin.
5	(b) Determination of Infection History.—In

- 16 (d) Conservation Reserve Program.—In this 17 section, the term "conservation reserve program" means 18 the program established under subchapter B of chapter
- 19 1 of subtitle D of title XII of the Food Security Act of 20 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3831 et seq.).

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
