- 5 Section 502(e) of the Employee Retirement Income
- 6 Security Act of 1974 (29 U.S.C. 1132(e)) is amended by
- 7 adding at the end the following new paragraph:

- 1 "(3) Notwithstanding any provision by the plan for
- 2 the exercise by a fidiciary of discretionary authority with
- 3 respect to any benefit determination, any benefit deter-
- 4 mination under the plan shall be subject to de novo review
- 5 by the court.".

6 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 7 The amendment made by section 1 of this Act shall
- 8 apply with respect to causes of action arising after the
- 9 date of the enactment of this Act.
