1 fore the period at the end the following: “, except that
2 for purposes of subparagraph (A)(v)(I), good cause shall
3 include demonstrating facts sufficient to establish a prima
4 facie case that the individual involved was victimized by
5 sexual harassment in violation of title VII of the Civil
6 Rights Act of 1964”.
