A BILL

For the relief of the family of Robert English.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RELIEF OF THE FAMILY OF ROBERT ENGLISH.
- 4 Notwithstanding the Public Safety Officers' Benefits
- 5 Act of 1976 (42 U.S.C. 3796 et seq.), the Bureau of Jus-
- 6 tice Assistance of the Department of Justice shall cause
- 7 the family of Robert English of Detroit, Michigan, to be
- 8 afforded relief that is fully commensurate with the relief
- 9 that would have been provided to the family pursuant to
- 10 that Act had the Bureau of Justice Assistance determined
- 11 that Robert English died as the direct and proximate re-
- 12 sult of a personal injury sustained in the line of duty.

1 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY FEES.

- 2 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-
- 3 cent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be paid
- 4 to, or received by, any agent or attorney for any service
- 5 rendered in connection with the claim described in such
- 6 section. Any person who violates this section shall be
- 7 guilty of an infraction, and shall be subject to a fine in
- 8 the amount provided in title 18, United States Code.
