A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to implement a budget-neutral payment system for rehabilitation services under part B of the Medicare Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Rehabilita-
- 5 tion Benefit Equity Act of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF FINANCIAL LIMITATION ON REHABILI-
- 7 TATION SERVICES.
- 8 (a) Repeal.—

- 1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 1833 of the Social 2 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l) is amended by strik-3 ing subsection (g).
- 4 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made 5 by paragraph (1) shall apply to services furnished on 6 or after July 1, 2000.
- 7 (b) Establishment of Alternative Payment 8 Methodology.—
 - (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for outpatient physical therapy services, outpatient occupational therapy services, and outpatient speech-language pathology services covered under title XVIII of the Social Security Act and furnished on or after July 1, 2000, the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall implement a payment methodology based on the classification of individuals by diagnostic category, functional status, and prior use of services in both inpatient and outpatient settings.
 - (2) Budget Neutrality in implementation.—Such payment methodology shall be designed so that the methodology does not result in any increase or decrease in the expenditures under title XVIII of such Act for fiscal year 2000 and fiscal year 2001.

1 (3) Adjustment for outyears.—For each 2 fiscal year after fiscal year 2001, the Secretary shall 3 provide for a percentage increase in the payment 4 rate under the methodology for the fiscal year in-5 volved that is equal to the Secretary's estimate of 6 the percentage increase in the MEI (as defined in 7 section 1842(i)(3)) of such Act for such fiscal year.
