5	Section 16 of the United States Housing Act of 1937
6	(42 U.S.C. 1437n) is amended by adding at the end the
7	following new subsection:
8	"(f) Ineligibility of Individuals Convicted of
9	Manufacturing or Producing Methamphetamine
10	On the Premises.—Notwithstanding any other provision
11	of law, a public housing agency shall establish standards
12	for occupancy in public housing dwelling units and assist-
13	ance under section 8 that—
14	"(1) permanently prohibit occupancy in any
15	public housing dwelling unit by, and assistance
16	under section 8 for, any person who has been con-
17	victed of manufacturing or otherwise producing
18	methamphetamine on the premises in violation of
19	any Federal or State law; and
20	"(2) immediately and permanently terminate
21	the tenancy in any public housing unit of, and the
22	assistance under section 8 for, any person who is
23	convicted of manufacturing or otherwise producing
24	methamphetamine on the premises in violation of
25	any Federal or State law.".
