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## A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to establish, for purposes of disability determinations under such title, a uniform minimum level of earnings, for demonstrating ability to engage in substantial gainful activity, at the level currently applicable solely to blind individuals.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. UNIFORM MINIMUM LEVEL OF EARNINGS FOR**  
4                       **DEMONSTRATING ABILITY TO ENGAGE IN**  
5                       **SUBSTANTIAL GAINFUL ACTIVITY.**

6       Section 223(d)(4) of the Social Security Act (42  
7       U.S.C. 423(d)(4)) is amended, in the second sentence, by

1 striking “No individual who is blind shall be regarded”  
2 and inserting “No individual shall be regarded”.

3 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4       The amendment made by section 1 shall apply to  
5 monthly insurance benefits for months after December  
6 1997.
