## A BILL

To establish restrictions on the provision to minors of contraceptive drugs and devices through family planning projects under title X of the Public Health Service Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Parental Notification
- 5 Act of 1998".

- 12 (C) In developing protocols under subpara-13 graphs (A) and (B), the Secretary shall consider the 14 results of research under title XX of the Public 15 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300z et seq.).
- 16 (d) Each provider of services under section 1001 of 17 title X of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300) 18 shall each year certify to the Secretary of Health and 19 Human Services compliance with this section. Such Sec-
- 20 retary shall prescribe such regulations as may be nec-
- 21 essary to effectuate this section.
