A BILL

To declare certain Amerasians to be citizens of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CITIZENSHIP FOR CERTAIN AMERASIANS.
- 4 Notwithstanding title III of the Immigration and Na-
- 5 tionality Act, or any other provision of law, any person
- 6 having the status of an alien lawfully admitted for perma-
- 7 nent residence (as defined in section 101(a) of the Immi-
- 8 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)) on the
- 9 date of the enactment of this Act, who was granted that
- 10 status pursuant to a petition filed under section 204(f)
- 11 of such Act (or any predecessor provision), is declared to

- 1 be a citizen of the United States as of the date of the
- 2 enactment of this Act.
