- 3 SECTION 1. BANNING ACCEPTANCE OF CASH CONTRIBU-
- 4 TIONS GREATER THAN \$100.
- 5 (a) In General.—Section 315 of the Federal Elec-
- 6 tion Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a) is amended
- 7 by adding at the end the following new subsection:
- 8 "(i) No candidate or political committee may accept
- 9 any contributions of currency of the United States or cur-

- 1 rency of any foreign country from any person which, in
- 2 the aggregate, exceed \$100.".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to elections occur-

5 ring after January 1999.
