A BILL

To amend the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to prohibit the use of funds for any facility a primary purpose of which is the distribution or use of tobacco products.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. USE OF FUNDS TO FACILITATE SALE OR USE
- 4 OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS PROHIBITED.
- 5 (a) In General.—Section 105 of the Housing and
- 6 Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5305)
- 7 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
- 8 section:

- 1 "(h) Ineligible Activities.—Notwithstanding sub-
- 2 section (a), activities under this title may not include the
- 3 acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, or
- 4 other improvement of any facility a primary or significant
- 5 purpose of which is the distribution, including sale, of any
- 6 tobacco product.".
- 7 (b) Funds Affected.—The amendment made by
- 8 subsection (a) shall not apply to funds which were obli-
- 9 gated by the Secretary of Housing and Human Develop-
- 10 ment before the date of the enactment of this Act.
