A BILL

To ensure that digital data services are made widely available to the American people.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Digital Data Services
- 5 Act of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. DIGITAL DATA SERVICES.
- 7 Section 336 of the Communications Act of 1934 (47
- 8 U.S.C. 336) is amended—
- 9 (1) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-
- section (h); and

1 (2) by inserting after subsection (f) the follow-2 ing new subsection:

"(g) Low-Power Television.—

"(1) Authorized USES.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any low-power television station licensed by the Commission may, at its option, utilize its authorized spectrum to provide any digital data services to those members of the public who choose to subscribe to or otherwise purchase such services. Such services may include (but are not limited to) digitally based interactive broadcast service; and wireless Internet access, whether one or two way, portable or fixed, or connected to the Internet via the interactive video and data services (IVDS) band or otherwise.

"(2) Notice of use.—A lower-power television station may provide the service authorized by this section upon filing notice with the Commission, except that the Commission may develop a form for the provision of such notice and, upon promulgation of such form, subsequent notices shall be provided via such form."
