## A BILL

To authorize electronic issuance and recognition of migratory bird hunting and conservation stamps.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Electronic Duck Stamp
- 5 Act of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. ELECTRONIC ISSUANCE OF MIGRATORY BIRD
- 7 HUNTING AND CONSERVATION STAMPS.
- 8 Section 2 of the Act of March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C.
- 9 718b), is amended by adding at the end the following:
- 10 "(c) Electronic Issuance of Stamps.—

| 4  | issued and sold through a means in use on the           |

| 8  | 'electronic stamp' means a representation of a          |
| 9  | stamp issued electronically under paragraph             |

| 11 | "(C) Stamp.—The term 'stamp' means a                    |
| 12 | migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp           |
| 13 | required by the first section.                          |
| 14 | "(2) Authorization.—The Department of the               |
| 15 | Interior, the Postal Service, or, subject to paragraph  |
| 16 | (7), a State or person authorized under subsection      |
| 17 | (a) to sell stamps, may issue the stamps, or rep-       |
| 18 | resentations of stamps, electronically by endorse-      |
| 19 | ment affixed to licenses issued at points of sale or    |
| 20 | through other electronic media. However, any such       |
| 21 | representation, if issued, shall be of a size less than |
| 22 | 3/4, or more than 11/2, in linear dimension, of the ac- |
| 23 | tual Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and Conserva-       |

tion Stamp (Federal Duck Stamp).

| 1  | "(3) Size of electronic stamps.—An elec-                      |

| 3  | or more than $1\frac{1}{2}$ , of the area of an actual stamp. |
| 4  | "(4) Confirmation number and other                            |
| 5  | IDENTIFYING INFORMATION.—                                     |
| 6  | "(A) CONFIRMATION NUMBER.—An elec-                            |
| 7  | tronic stamp shall be assigned a unique con-                  |
| 8  | firmation number.   |
| 9  | "(B) OTHER IDENTIFYING INFORMA-                               |
| 10 | TION.—Each issuer of an electronic stamp or                   |
| 11 | unique confirmation number shall also print on                |
| 12 | any representation or pertinent license issued,               |
| 13 | appropriate information for Federal, State, and               |
| 14 | other law enforcement officers to verify the con-             |
| 15 | firmation number, representation, and sales                   |
| 16 | transaction with the licensee.                                |
| 17 | "(5) Delivery of actual stamps.—An entity                     |
| 18 | that issues electronic stamps or representations              |
| 19 | under paragraph (1) shall have financial responsibil-         |
| 20 | ity for the sale, delivery, and mailing of the cor-           |
| 21 | responding printed (actual) Federal Migratory Bird            |
| 22 | Hunting and Conservation Stamp to the licensee                |
| 23 | within 14 calendar days of issuance.                          |
| 24 | "(6) Recognition of electronic stamps.—                       |

| 1  | "(A) In General.—An electronic stamp                  |

| 2  | and its unique confirmation number shall—             |
| 3  | "(i) subject to the requirements of the               |
| 4  | first section, be given full recognition dur-         |
| 5  | ing the period beginning on the date of               |
| 6  | issuance of the electronic stamp until the            |
| 7  | date on which the corresponding actual                |
| 8  | stamp is received; and                                |
| 9  | "(ii) expire and be replaced by the ac-               |
| 10 | tual stamp upon receipt of the actual                 |
| 11 | stamp, but not later than 14 calendar days            |
| 12 | after the date of issuance of the electronic          |
| 13 | stamp, if the licensee complies with the re-          |
| 14 | quirements of the first section.                      |
| 15 | "(7) Approval by the secretary.—No State              |
| 16 | or other person may participate in the electronic     |
| 17 | issuance of a Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and      |
| 18 | Conservation Stamp unless the Secretary has re-       |
| 19 | ceived a plan submitted by the party in question      |
| 20 | which provides for a satisfactory accounting process  |
| 21 | for the collection and transfer of revenue, distribu- |
| 22 | tion, and law enforcement verification of the elec-   |
| 23 | tronic transaction, and the subsequent distribution   |
| 24 | of the actual stamp.                                  |

"(8) ELECTRONIC COLLECTION OF ELECTRONIC STAMP SALES REVENUE.—Not later than 14 days after the date of issuance of an electronic stamp under this subsection, a State or person shall transfer to the Department of the Interior or a designated agent the revenue collected from the issuance by means of an electronic fund transfer method approved by, and compatible with, the accounting system of the Department of the Interior or the designated agent.".
