- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Safe Neighborhood Act
- 5 of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. OCCUPANCY OF GROUP HOMES BY CERTAIN CRIMI-
- 7 NALS.
- 8 Section 807 of the Fair Housing Act (42 U.S.C.
- 9 3607) is amended by adding at the end the following:

- 1 "(c) Nothing in this title limits the applicability of
- 2 any reasonable local, State, or Federal restriction on the
- 3 occupancy of group homes by persons convicted of crimes

4 for which a term or imprisonment was imposed.".
