## A BILL

To authorize the Disabled Veterans' LIFE Memorial Foundation to establish a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs to honor veterans who became disabled while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. MEMORIAL TO HONOR DISABLED VETERANS
- 4 OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES.
- 5 (a) Memorial Authorized.—The Disabled Veter-
- 6 ans' LIFE Memorial Foundation is authorized to establish
- 7 a memorial on Federal land in the District of Columbia

- 1 or its environs to honor veterans who became disabled
- 2 while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.
- 3 (b) Compliance With Standards for Commemo-
- 4 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
- 5 be in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
- 6 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).
- 7 (c) Payment of Expenses.—The Disabled Veter-
- 8 ans' LIFE Memorial Foundation shall be solely respon-
- 9 sible for acceptance of contributions for, and payment of
- 10 the expenses of, the establishment of the memorial. No
- 11 Federal funds may be used to pay any expense of the es-
- 12 tablishment of the memorial.
- 13 (d) Deposit of Excess Funds.—If, upon payment
- 14 of all expenses of the establishment of the memorial (in-
- 15 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount re-
- 16 quired under section 8(b) of the Commemorative Works
- 17 Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b))), or upon expiration of the au-
- 18 thority for the memorial under section 10(b) of such Act
- 19 (40 U.S.C. 1010(b)), there remains a balance of funds re-
- 20 ceived for the establishment of the memorial, the Disabled
- 21 Veterans' LIFE Memorial Foundation shall transmit the
- 22 amount of the balance to the Secretary of the Treasury
- 23 for deposit in the account provided for in section 8(b)(1)
- 24 of such Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b)(1)).
