## A BILL

To prohibit the Department of State from imposing a charge or fee for providing passport information to the general public.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Freedom of Passport
- 5 Information Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AND REQUIREMENT CONCERNING
- 7 DEPARTMENT OF STATE PASSPORT INFOR-
- 8 MATION SERVICES.
- 9 For fiscal year 1998 and for each subsequent fiscal
- 10 year, the Secretary of State shall provide for a United

- 1 States passport information telephone inquiry service for
- 2 the general public which shall be available without charge
- 3 or fee imposed by the Department of State or any other

4 entity under contract to the Department of State.
