To amend the General Education Provisions Act to allow State and county prosecutors access to student records in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PROTECTION OF THE RIGHTS AND PRIVACY OF

PARENTS AND STUDENTS.

Section 444(b) of the General Education Provisions

Act (20 U.S.C. 1221) is amended by adding at the end
the following:

"(7) Nothing in this section shall be construed
to require a State or county prosecutor to obtain a

court order to receive student information, before or

- 1 after adjudication, if the information sought pertains
- 2 to a criminal investigation or prosecution of such

3 student.".
