1 **SECTION 1. OPERATION OF COMBINED POST EXCHANGE**
2 **AND COMMISSARY STORE, CASTLE AIR**
3 **FORCE BASE, CALIFORNIA.**

4 (a) BX MART REQUIRED.—Subsection (c) of section
5 2490a of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) by striking out the subsection heading and
7 inserting in lieu thereof the following: “OPERATION
8 REQUIRED AT CERTAIN INSTALLATIONS.—(1)”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new
10 paragraph:

11 “(2) The military installations selected as the sites
12 for the operation of a combined exchange and commissary
13 store under this section shall also include Castle Air Force
14 Base, California. The Secretary of Defense shall ensure
15 that the combined exchange and commissary store is fully
16 operational at Castle Air Force Base not later than one
17 year after the date of the enactment of this paragraph.”.

18 (b) CONFORMING CHANGE IN NUMBER OF AUTHOR-
19 IZED BX MARTS.—Subsection (b) of such section is
20 amended by striking out “ten” and inserting in lieu there-
21 of “11”.
