To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide that military reservists who are retained in active status after qualifying for reserve retired pay shall be given credit toward computation of such retired pay for service performed after so qualifying.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPUTATION OF YEARS OF SERVICE IN COM-**
4 **PUTING RESERVE RETIRED PAY.**

5 (a) CREDIT FOR DAYS AFTER QUALIFYING FOR RE-
6 TIRED PAY.—Section 12733(1) of title 10, United States

1 Code, is amended by inserting before the period the follow-
2 ing: “, including the person’s days served in active status
3 after qualifying for retired pay under this chapter, which
4 shall be credited when the person leaves active status”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) shall apply to any person who qualifies after
7 January 1, 1988, for retired pay under chapter 1223 of
8 title 10, United States Code, or under chapter 67 of such
9 title as in effect before December 1, 1994.
