1	SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON PROVISION OF DUTY-FREE
2	TREATMENT FOR LIVE PLANTS AND FRESH
3	CUT FLOWERS UNDER THE ANDEAN TRADE
4	PREFERENCES ACT.
5	(a) In General.—Section 204 of the Andean Trade
6	Preference Act (19 U.S.C. 3203) is amended—
7	(1) in subsection (b)—
8	(A) in paragraph (7), by striking "or" at
9	the end;
10	(B) in paragraph (8), by striking the pe-
11	riod at the end and inserting "; or"; and
12	(C) by adding at the end the following:
13	"(9) live plants and fresh cut flowers described
14	in chapter 6 of the HTS."; and
15	(2) in subsection (e)(5)—
16	(A) by striking subparagraph (A); and
17	(B) by redesignating subparagraphs (B)
18	through (D) as subparagraphs (A) through (C),
19	respectively.
20	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
21	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods that are
22	entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption,
23	on or after the date that is 15 days after the date of enact-
24	ment of this Act.
