- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Plant Genetic Con-
- 5 servation Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. APPROPRIATION FOR PLANT GENETIC CONSERVA-
- 7 TION.
- 8 The following sums are appropriated, out of any
- 9 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for fis-
- 10 cal year 1998:
