Mr. FROST introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Banking and Financial Services

A BILL

To amend the Federal Credit Union Act to clarify that residents of certain neighborhoods which are underserved by depository institutions may become members of any Federal credit union which establishes a branch in such neighborhood.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Improved Availability
5 of Banking Services in Underserved Communities Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF LAW RELATING TO ELIGIBILITY**
2 **OF MEMBERSHIP IN FEDERAL CREDIT**
3 **UNIONS.**

4 Section 109 of the Federal Credit Union Act (12
5 U.S.C. 1759) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “Federal credit union member-
7 ship” and inserting “(a) IN GENERAL.—Federal
8 credit union membership”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10 section:

11 “(b) BANKING SERVICES FOR UNDERSERVED
12 NEIGHBORHOODS.—Notwithstanding any provision of
13 subsection (a), any resident of any neighborhood or com-
14 munity which the Board determines—

15 “(1) is a community which meets the require-
16 ments of paragraph (3) and subparagraphs (A) and
17 (B) of paragraph (4) of section 233(b) of the Bank
18 Enterprise Act of 1991, and such additional require-
19 ments as the Board may impose; and

20 “(2) is underserved by other depository institu-
21 tions (as defined in section 19(b)(1)(A) of the Fed-
22 eral Reserve Act),

23 may be elected to the membership of any Federal credit
24 union which establishes and maintains a branch in such
25 neighborhood or community.”.
