## A BILL

3       **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF MONTGOMERY, ROANOKE, AND**  
4                       **ROCKBRIDGE COUNTIES, VIRGINIA, AS PART**  
5                       **OF APPALACHIAN REGION.**

6       The 12th undesignated paragraph of section 403 of  
7       the Appalachian Regional Development Act of 1965 (40  
8       U.S.C. App. 403) is amended—

- 1           (1) by inserting “Montgomery,” after “Lee,”;
- 2       and
- 3           (2) by inserting “Roanoke, Rockbridge,” after
- 4       “Pulaski,”.
