- 6 Section 8(5)(A) of the Agricultural Adjustment Act
- 7 (7 U.S.C. 608c(5)(A)), reenacted with amendments by the

- 1 Agricultural Marketing Agreement Act of 1937, is amend-
- 2 ed by adding at the end the following new sentence: "In-
- 3 formation from the National Cheese Exchange may not
- 4 be used to fix minimum prices for milk of any use classi-

5 fication.".
