- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF PURCHASE.
- 4 Thomas McDermott, Senior, of Oshkosh, Wisconsin,
- 5 is authorized to purchase, at fair market value, the real
- 6 property of the United States in Grant County, New Mex-
- 7 ico, to which Mr. McDermott's mineral patent application
- 8 applied and the Bureau of Land Management of the De-
- 9 partment of the Interior is directed to enter into negotia-
- 10 tions with Mr. McDermott for the purchase of such real
- 11 property. Such application is Mr. McDermott's application
- 12 filed under the Act of May 10, 1872 (30 U.S.C. 22 et

- 1 seq.) (referred to as the "1872 Mining Law") identified
- 2 as mineral patent application NMNM 78359. Such pur-
- 3 chase shall be made not later than 6 months after the date

4 of the enactment of this Act.
