- 6 end the following new subparagraph:
- 7 "(C) In prescribing regulations pursuant to subpara-
- 8 graph (A)(ii), the Secretary shall provide for the exclusion

1	from the calculation of placement rates, graduates who
2	are—
3	"(i) aliens not authorized to accept employment
4	in the United States;
5	"(ii) individuals with medical conditions pre-
6	cluding employment; and
7	"(iii) individuals who transfer credits from the
8	program to the program of an accredited degree-
9	granting institution or who otherwise immediately
10	enroll in such a program.".
