- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Wage Act of
- 5 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. RAISE IN MINIMUM WAGE.
- 7 Section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of
- 8 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended to read as follows:

"(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-1 2 tion, not less than \$4.75 an hour during the period 3 beginning October 1, 1996, and ending August 31, 4 1997, not less than \$5.15 an hour during the period beginning September 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 5 6 1998, not less than \$5.50 an hour during the year beginning July 1, 1998, not less than \$6.00 an hour 7 8 during the year beginning July 1, 1999, and not less 9 than \$6.50 an hour beginning July 1, 2000;".
