7 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396b(m)(2)(A)(ii)) is
8 waived with respect to HealthCare USA, Inc. and
9 Ultramedix Health Care Systems Inc. operating in Florida

- 1 for contract periods beginning on or after July 1, 1996,
- 2 and ending on or before June 30, 2000.
