A BILL

To provide off-budget treatment for one-half of the receipts and disbursements of the land and water conservation fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. OFF-BUDGET TREATMENT FOR ONE-HALF OF

THE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF

LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law except

the Line Item Veto Act of 1996, one-half of the receipts

and disbursements of the receipts and disbursements of

the land and water conservation fund—

1	(1) shall not be counted as new budget author-
2	ity, outlays, receipts, or deficit or surplus for pur-
3	poses of—
4	(A) the budget of the United States Gov-
5	ernment as submitted by the President,
6	(B) the congressional budget (including al-
7	locations of budget authority and outlays pro-
8	vided therein), or
9	(C) the Balanced Budget and Emergency
10	Deficit Control Act of 1985; and
11	(2) shall be exempt from any general budget
12	limitation imposed by statute on expenditures and
13	net lending (budget outlays) of the United States
14	Government.
