Mr. RICHARDSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize an appropriation for the construction of a public museum located in, and relating to the history of, the State of New Mexico.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT FOR MUSEUM.**

4 (a) **AUTHORITY TO MAKE GRANT.**—With funds ap-
5 propriated to carry out this subsection and subject to the
6 requirement specified in subsection (b), the Secretary of
7 the Interior shall make a grant to the State of New Mexico
8 for the construction of a public museum in the city of
9 Santa Fe to house and display art and artifacts relating
10 to the history of the State of New Mexico.

1 (b) MATCHING FUNDS REQUIRED.—To be eligible to
2 receive a grant under subsection (a), the State of New
3 Mexico shall submit to the Secretary of the Interior an
4 application that includes an agreement by such State to
5 expend not less than \$11,000,000 of non-Federal funds
6 for the construction of the museum described in subsection
7 (a).

8 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

9 There is authorized to be appropriated \$9,000,000 to
10 carry out section 1(a).
