A BILL

To designate the national cemetery established at the former site of the Joliet Arsenal, Illinois, as the “Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL CEMETERY.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The national cemetery estab-
5 lished at the former site of the Joliet Arsenal, Illinois,
6 shall be known and designated as the “Abraham Lincoln
7 National Cemetery”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, paper, or other record of the United States to the

1 national cemetery referred to in subsection (a) shall be
2 deemed to be a reference to the “Abraham Lincoln Na-
3 tional Cemetery”.
