# A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to increase the maximum Pell Grant.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Affordable Higher
- 5 Education-Through-Pell Grants Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCREASE IN MAXIMUM PELL GRANTS.
- 7 Section 401(b)(2)(A) of the Higher Education Act of
- 8 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(b)(2)(A)) is amended by striking
- 9 clauses (i) through (v) and inserting the following:
- 10 "(i) \$4,500 for academic year 1997–1998, and

- 1 "(ii) \$5,000 for academic year 1998–1999 and
- 2 each of the 4 succeeding academic years,".

#### 3 SEC. 3. FUNDING OF PELL GRANTS.

- 4 Section 401 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20
- 5 U.S.C. 1070a) is further amended by adding at the end
- 6 the following new subsection:
- 7 "(j) Funds for Expenses.—There shall be avail-
- 8 able to the Secretary, from funds not otherwise appro-
- 9 priated, such sums as may be necessary to provide funds
- 10 to be obligated for the costs of the grants under this sec-
- 11 tion in the maximum amounts authorized by this sec-
- 12 tion.".
