- 3 SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF LIVESTOCK SOLD ON ACCOUNT
- 4 OF WEATHER-RELATED CONDITIONS.
- 5 (a) Deferral of Income Inclusion.—Subsection
- 6 (e) of section 451 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
- 7 (relating to special rules for proceeds from livestock sold
- 8 on account of drought) is amended—

1	(1) by striking "drought conditions, and that
2	these drought conditions" in paragraph (1) and in-
3	serting "drought or other weather-related conditions,
4	and that such conditions"; and
5	(2) by inserting ", or Other Weather-Re-
6	LATED CONDITIONS" after "Drought" in the sub-
7	section heading.
8	(b) Involuntary Conversions.—Subsection (e) of
9	section 1033 of such Code (relating to livestock sold on
10	account of drought) is amended—
11	(1) by inserting "or other weather-related con-
12	ditions" before the period at the end thereof; and
13	(2) by inserting ", or Other Weather-Re-
14	LATED CONDITIONS" after "Drought" in the sub-
15	section heading.
16	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
17	this section shall apply to sales and exchanges after De-
18	cember 31, 1996.
