1	SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITY TO
2	SPECIFY "MULTIRACIAL" OR "MULTIETHNIC",
3	RESPECTIVELY, AS RACIAL OR ETHNIC CLAS-
4	SIFICATION.
5	(a) In General.—Section 3507 of title 44, United
6	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the follow-
7	ing new subsection:
8	"(k) The Director may not approve a collection of in-
9	formation that would request or direct a respondent to
10	specify a racial classification from among a list of racial
11	classifications, or an ethnic classification from among a
12	list of ethnic classifications, the approval of such a collec-
13	tion of information by the Director shall not be inferred,
14	and an agency shall not sponsor or conduct such a collec-
15	tion of information, unless the list provides an opportunity
16	for the respondent to specify 'multiracial', in the case of
17	a list of racial classifications, or 'multiethnic', in the case
18	of a list of ethnic classifications.".
19	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
20	subsection (a) shall take effect January 1, 1998.
