3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION AGAINST THE DISPOSITION OF A**
4 **FIREARM TO, AND THE POSSESSION OF A**
5 **FIREARM BY, NON-PERMANENT RESIDENT**
6 **ALIENS.**

7 (a) PROHIBITIONS.—Paragraph (5) of each of sub-
8 sections (d) and (g) of section 922 of title 18, United
9 States Code, is amended by inserting
10 “, or is not lawfully admitted for permanent residence in

1 the United States under the Immigration and Nationality
2 Act” before the semicolon.

3 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
4 922(s)(3)(B)(v) of such title is amended by inserting
5 “, or not lawfully admitted for permanent residence in the
6 United States under the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act” before the semicolon.
