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## A BILL

To provide for funding for Federal employee pay adjustments  
and comparability payments through reductions in agency  
spending on service contracts for fiscal year 1998.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR FEDERAL EMPLOYEE PAY AD-**  
2 **JUSTMENTS AND COMPARABILITY PAYMENTS**  
3 **THROUGH REDUCTIONS IN AGENCY SPEND-**  
4 **ING FOR SERVICE CONTRACTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Of the funds provided in appro-  
6 priation Acts for fiscal year 1998 to all departments, agen-  
7 cies, and instrumentalities in the executive branch of the  
8 Federal Government—

9 (1) the total amount otherwise available for  
10 purposes of entering into service contracts with pri-  
11 vate entities is hereby reduced by \$5,700,000,000;  
12 and

13 (2) the total amount otherwise available for  
14 purposes of pay schedule adjustments and locality-  
15 based comparability payments under sections 5303  
16 and 5304 of title 5, United States Code, is hereby  
17 increased by such sum.

18 (b) ALLOCATION OF AMOUNTS.—The Director of the  
19 Office of Management and Budget shall allocate the re-  
20 ductions and increases required by subsection (a) among  
21 the appropriate accounts, and shall submit to the Con-  
22 gress a report setting forth such allocation.

23 (c) AGENCY CERTIFICATION.—Each department,  
24 agency, and instrumentality in the executive branch of the  
25 Federal Government shall submit to the Director of the  
26 Office of Management and Budget, within 90 days after

1 the end of fiscal year 1998, a certification of compliance  
2 with subsection (a) in accordance with the allocations  
3 made pursuant to subsection (b). Not later than 120 days  
4 after the end of fiscal year 1998, the Director shall submit  
5 to the Congress a report setting forth the certifications  
6 of compliance received by the Director under this sub-  
7 section.

8 (d) SERVICE CONTRACTS.—For the purposes of this  
9 section the term “service contract” has the meaning given  
10 such term in part 37 of title 48 of the Code of Federal  
11 Regulations.

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
