- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REDUCED RATE OF POSTAGE.
- 4 The United States Postal Service shall establish a
- 5 discount presort first-class postage rate for specified local
- 6 governmental mailings—

1	(1) that are mandated by Federal or State law,
2	such as property tax statements, summonses, and
3	jury-duty pay; but

(2) for which no Federal or State funds are provided to local governments to defray the associated administrative costs.
