# A BILL

To require random drug testing within the executive branch of the Government.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Executive Branch
- 5 Drug Testing Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. RANDOM DRUG TESTING.
- 7 (a) In General.—All officers and employees within
- 8 the executive branch of the Government shall be subject
- 9 to random drug testing in accordance with regulations
- 10 prescribed by the President.

- 1 (b) Definition.—For purposes of this Act, the term
- 2 "drug" means a controlled substance, as defined by sec-
- 3 tion 102(6) of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C.
- 4 802(6)).

### 5 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 6 Any regulations necessary to carry out this Act shall
- 7 be issued in time so that they may be implemented begin-
- 8 ning not later than the 90th day after the date of the en-
- 9 actment of this Act.
