- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1928(b)(2) of the Social
- 7 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396s(b)(2)) is amended—

1	(1) in subparagraph (A)(iii), by striking "(I)"
2	and all that follows through " (Π) ", and
3	(2) in subparagraph (B)(ii)(II), by striking
4	``(A)(iii)(II)'' and inserting $``(A)(iii)''$.
5	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
6	subsection (a) shall apply to vaccines administered on or
7	after October 1, 1997, without regard to whether or not
8	regulations to carry out such amendments have been pro-
9	mulgated by such date.
