A BILL

To prohibit the cloning of humans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Human Cloning Prohi-
- 5 bition Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST CLONING OF HUMANS.
- 7 (a) In General.—It shall be unlawful for any per-
- 8 son to use a human somatic cell for the process of produc-
- 9 ing a human clone.

- 1 (b) CIVIL MONEY PENALTY.—Any person who vio-
- 2 lates subsection (a) is liable to the United States for a

3 civil money penalty in an amount not exceeding \$5,000.
