- 3 SECTION 1. ACQUISITION OF GOODS AND SERVICES RELAT-
- 4 ED TO FIREFIGHTING.
- 5 The Secretary of Agriculture, acting through the
- 6 Chief of the Forest Service, may place an order with a

- 1 major organizational unit within the Department of Agri-
- 2 culture or another Federal agency for goods or services
- 3 directly related to firefighting without regard to the re-
- 4 striction contained in section 1535(a)(4) of title 31, Unit-
- 5 ed States Code, that the Secretary determine that the
- 6 goods or services cannot be provided by contract as con-
- 7 veniently or cheaply by a commercial enterprise.
