AN ACT

To provide for the expansion of the Eagles Nest Wilderness within Arapaho and White River National Forests, Colorado, to include the lands known as the Slate Creek Addition upon the acquisition of the lands by the United States.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SLATE CREEK ADDITION TO EAGLES NEST WIL-
4	DERNESS, ARAPAHO AND WHITE RIVER NA-
5	TIONAL FORESTS, COLORADO.
6	(a) Slate Creek Addition.—If the parcel of land
7	described in subsection (b) is conveyed to the United
8	States on or before December 31, 2000, the parcel shall
9	be included in, and managed as part of, the Eagles Nest
10	Wilderness designated by Public Law 94–352 (90 Stat.
11	870; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note). Upon conveyance of the par-
12	cel, the boundary of the Eagles Nest Wilderness is ad-
13	justed to include the parcel.
14	(b) Description of Addition.—The parcel re-
15	ferred to in subsection (a) is generally depicted on a map
16	entitled "Slate Creek Addition-Eagles Nest Wilderness",
17	dated February 1997, which shall be available for public
18	inspection in the office of the Forest Supervisor of the
19	White River National Forest in the State of Colorado. The
20	parcel comprises approximately 160 acres in Summit
21	County, Colorado, adjacent to the Eagles Nest Wilderness.
