AN ACT

For the relief of Lloyd B. Gamble.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.

- 2 (a) Payment.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall
- 3 pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise ap-
- 4 propriated, to Lloyd B. Gamble of Fairfax, Virginia, the
- 5 sum of \$253,488.
- 6 (b) Basis.—The payment required by subsection (a)
- 7 shall be to compensate Lloyd B. Gamble for the injuries
- 8 sustained by him as a result of the administration to him,
- 9 without his knowledge, of lysergic acid diethylamide by
- 10 United States Army personnel in 1957.

11 SEC. 2. SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS.

- The payment made pursuant to section 1 shall be in
- 13 full satisfaction of all claims Lloyd B. Gamble may have
- 14 against the United States for any injury described in such
- 15 section.

16 SEC. 3. INELIGIBILITY FOR ADDITIONAL BENEFITS.

- 17 Upon payment of the sum referred to in section 1,
- 18 Lloyd B. Gamble shall not be eligible for any compensa-
- 19 tion or benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs
- 20 or the Department of Defense for any injury described in
- 21 such section.

22 SEC. 4. LIMITATION OF AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.

- It shall be unlawful for an amount of more than 10
- 24 percent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be
- 25 paid to or received by any agent or attorney for any service
- 26 rendered to Lloyd B. Gamble in connection with the bene-

- 1 fits provided by this Act. Any person who violates this sec-
- 2 tion shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject
- 3 to a fine in the amount provided in title 18, United States
- 4 Code.
