RESOLUTION

To amend the Rules of the House of Representatives to permit disabled individuals who have access to the House floor to bring supporting services.

1 *Resolved*,

2 **SECTION 1. SUPPORTING SERVICES.**

3 Rule XXXII of the Rules of the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(6) Clerks of committees and persons from Member’s staffs who have a disability (as defined in section 7 3 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42

1 U.S.C. 12102) and who have access to the Hall of the
2 House may bring supporting services (including service
3 dogs, wheelchairs, and interpreters) into the Hall of the
4 House.”.
