Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2159) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
- 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
- 5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2159) making appropriations for

foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, and for 3 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-4 pensed with. Points of order against consideration of the bill for failure to comply with clause 2(1)(6) of rule XI or clause 7 of rule XXI are waived. General debate shall 6 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-8 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations. After 10 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order against provi-12 sions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: beginning with ": Provided" on page 24, line 8, through "justice" on line 14 15 16. Where points of order are waived against part of a paragraph, points or order against a provision in another 16 17 part of such paragraph may be made only against such 18 provision and not against the entire paragraph. The 19 amendments printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution may be offered only 20 21 by a Member designated in the report and only at the appropriate point in the reading of the bill, shall be consid-23 ered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment ex-

- 1 cept as specified in the report, and shall not be subject
- 2 to a demand for division of the question in the House or
- 3 in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
- 4 the amendments printed in the report are waived. No
- 5 other amendment shall be in order unless printed in the
- 6 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that
- 7 purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. The Chairman of the
- 8 Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time
- 9 during further consideration in the Committee of the
- 10 Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amendment;
- 11 and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time for elec-
- 12 tronic voting on any postponed question that follows an-
- 13 other electronic vote without intervening business, pro-
- 14 vided that the minimum time for electronic voting on the
- 15 first in any series of questions shall be fifteen minutes.
- 16 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
- 17 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
- 18 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
- 19 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
- 20 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
- 21 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
- 22 or without instructions.
