Mr. Dreier, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## **RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2264) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
- 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
- 5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2264) making appropriations for

the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, 2 and Education, and related agencies, for the fiscal year 3 ending September 30, 1998, and for other purposes. The 4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-6 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-8 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-10 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply 12 with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: beginning with ": Provided" on page 41, line 26, through "\$2,245,000,000" on page 42, line 3. Where 14 15 points of order are waived against part of a paragraph, points of order against a provision in another part of such 16 17 paragraph may be made only against such provision and not against the entire paragraph. The amendments print-18 19 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution may be offered only by a Member des-20 21 ignated in the report and only at the appropriate point in the reading of the bill, shall be considered as read, shall 23 not be subject to amendment except as specified in the report and except pro forma amendments offered for the purpose of debate, and shall not be subject to a demand

for division of the question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against the amend-3 ments printed in the report are waived. During consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congres-8 sional Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered 10 as read. The Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further consider-12 ation in the Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any 14 15 postponed question that follows another electronic vote without intervening business, provided that the minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any series of questions shall be fifteen minutes. During consideration of the 18 bill, points of order against amendments for failure to 19 comply with clause 2(e) of rule XXI are waived. At the 20 21 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the 22 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with 23 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
