3 waiving certain enrollment requirements with respect to
4 two specified bills of the One Hundred Fifth Congress.

6 equally divided and controlled by the majority leader and

1 the minority leader or their designees. The previous ques-
2 tion shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolution
3 to final passage without intervening motion except one
4 motion to commit.
