Mr. Lampson submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on International Relations

RESOLUTION

Calling for the prosecution of Pol Pot for crimes against humanity.

- Whereas the Khmer Rouge government of Democratic Kampuchea (Cambodia) carried out as governmental policy the systematic genocide of the Cambodian people between 1975 and 1979;
- Whereas that government engaged in torture and the murder of civilians as state policy;
- Whereas that government was responsible for the murder of between one to two million Cambodians from 1975 to 1979; and
- Whereas Pol Pot, as leader of the Khmer Rouge during this period, was directly responsible for the planning and implementation of this state directed policy of genocide: Now, therefore, be it

1 Resolved,'	That the	House of	Representatives—

- (1) urges the Secretary of State to take actions, consistent with the Cambodian Genocide Justice Act (22 U.S.C. 2656 note), that lead to the prosecution of Pol Pot for crimes against humanity;
- (2) calls upon the international community, through the United Nations Security Council and other appropriate international governmental bodies, to convene an international tribunal for the adjudication of the case of Pol Pot; and
- (3) recommends that the Secretary of State take all feasible steps to create an international tribunal for the prosecution of Pol Pot if such a tribunal has not been established by an international organization by January 30, 1998.
